Lent has returned. Lent is "a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday". According to the lectionary of this year (Year B), Lent will begin on February 14 (which is Valentine's Day, too!) and end on March 30. During this season, Christians remember and meditate on Christ's life, ministry, passion, death, and resurrection, and prepare themselves for celebrating Easter. I would like us to join this journey with Jesus Christ together, confirming or reaffirming our calling.

This Lenten season, we will have special worship services with our fellow believers in Christ of the United Methodist Church of Holyoke, South Hadley, and Granby. On Ash Wednesday (Feb. 14), we will worship God together in South Hadley, while our church will host a Maundy Thursday service on March 28. 

These numbers were recently reported to us by St. Pauly Textile, Inc., the company that placed the clothing shed in our parking lot and empties it each week.

69,351 is the number of pounds of clothing that was donated to our shed in 2023. This equates to 34.7 **TONS.**

12,775 is the number of people who were clothed all over the world as a result of the donations received in our shed.

\$2,774.00 is the amount of money that Faith has received because of the clothing donations received.

St. Pauly Textile expressed their appreciation and thanks for the volume of donations received during 2023.




Bible Study on Zoom


