## Scripture Reading: 1 Corinthians 3:5-15 p.167 NT

<sup>5</sup> What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned to each. <sup>6</sup>I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. <sup>7</sup> So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth.<sup>8</sup> The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and each will receive wages according to their own labor.<sup>9</sup> For we are God's coworkers, working together; you are God's field, God's building.<sup>10</sup> According to the grace of God given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Let each builder choose with care how to build on it. <sup>11</sup> For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup> Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—<sup>13</sup> the work of each builder will become visible, for the day<sup>[a]</sup> will disclose it, because it will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each has done.<sup>14</sup> If the work that someone has built on the foundation survives, the builder will receive a wage. <sup>15</sup> If the work is burned up, the builder will suffer loss; the builder will be saved, but only as through fire.
